Past Simple (I ate lunch) VS Present Perfect Simple (I have eaten lunch)

Present Perfect Simple	Past Simple
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I have lost my wallet. → <i>I lost it recently and I don't have it now.</i> <p><i>We can use present perfect for something that happened recently and that has a connection to now (I don't have my wallet now).</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I lost my wallet yesterday. (<i>I don't know about the status <u>now</u></i>)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I haven't seen Jane (yet). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I didn't see Jane at all last week.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I haven't spoken to David. I haven't spoken to David yet. <p><i>No time expression in the past or finished time. (e.g. last week, last year, yesterday etc.)</i></p> <p><i>We use words like "just", "already", "yet" and "so far".</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I haven't spoken to David yet. I have just spoken to David. I haven't seen David so far. I have already spoken to David. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I have spoken to David this morning. (<i>unfinished time</i>) I haven't spoken to David today. I spoke to David 2 weeks ago.
